

THE COST OF EMPLOYEES' POOR HEALTH

Every year, chronic illnesses and injuries among the U.S. workforce cost employers billions of dollars due to absences and lost or reduced productivity.*

\$82 Billion

Cost of missed revenues, hiring temp workers, and overtime

\$178 Billion

Cost for wages and benefits for incidental absences due to illness, workers' comp and FMLA

\$198 Billion

Cost of diminished productivity due to unmanaged or poorly managed chronic health conditions

\$73 Billion

Cost for workers' compensation treatments and related costs

1.4 Billion

Days of absence and illness-related lost productivity
